- a.) The tuition and fee amounts in the financial aid budget are based on 22 hours per semester for 1st year students and 12 hours per semester for 2nd year students. The tuition and fee amounts for students in the masters program are based on 12 hours for fall semester and 8 hours for spring semester.
- b.) Students must purchase their books and supplies. Students should come to SIUC with sufficient funds to buy books, supplies and any other items necessary to begin the semester, even if the student is expecting financial aid or plans to work on campus. SIUC does not issue book vouchers. The books and supplies allowance is based on full-time enrollment, but books and supply expenses will vary based on the courses that the student is taking.
- c.) Living expenses vary greatly based on the individual student's lifestyle. The allowance includes transportation, clothing, living expenses not covered by on-campus housing, recreation, and other miscellaneous costs.

SIUC offers an installment plan to assist students and families in managing their educational expenses. The following Fall 2008 Payment Plan Schedule has been developed as a guide for your planning purposes. The Advanced Housing Contract and the monthly Statement of Account are the University's official billing documents. Financial Aid credited to the student's account will reduce the total tuition, fees and room & board charges. The amount due will be approximately one-fourth of the net charges.
