If you have not previously filed, you must file a 2007-08 FAFSA by June 30, 2008 to be considered for Summer Session 2008 financial aid.

PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT THIS FORM UNTIL YOU HAVE FINALIZED YOUR REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER. If you submit this application prior to being registered for at least 6 credit hours you will only be considered for loans and will not be considered for institutional gift aid.

❖ **NOTE** ❖

Undergraduate students **MUST ENROLL AND CONTINUE TO BE ENROLLED FOR AT LEAST 6 CREDIT HOURS** for summer semester to be considered for Campus-Based Aid and Federal Direct Stafford/Ford Loans. Failure to maintain at least 6 credit hours will result in all Campus-Based Aid and Federal Direct Stafford/Ford Loan funds being removed from your account. "WF" and "WU" grades can result in reduced credit hours and the removal of your financial aid. Financial aid cannot be reinstated if cancelled, once the enrollment period has ended.

The Federal Pell Grant Program considers 12 credit hours as full-time, 9 to 11 credit hours as three-quarter time, and 6 to 8 credit hours as half-time. Federal Pell Grant funds for summer are only awarded to students who did not use their full Pell Grant annual award during the previous fall and spring semesters.

Summer financial aid is based upon an average enrollment of seven (7) credit hours for undergraduate students. If you are enrolled for more than the average enrollment and you have remaining Federal Direct Stafford/Ford Loan eligibility you may request an increase in your cost of attendance beginning June 16, 2008. Cost of attendance increases will not be processed for ILP (Individualized Learning Program) classes.
