### Potential Research Project(s) for McNair Scholar

Research will focus on stereotypes and prejudice using two different techniques: (1) Self-reports, and (2) implicit cognitive tasks reaction time to primed target stimuli.

### Faculty Mentor Expectations of McNair Scholar

The McNair Scholar will be expected to work from 20 to 40 hours a week choosing the experimental stimuli, developing the computer programs for the primary tasks, developing related experimental procedure, and running subjects.
